## 1. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE, CALL TO ORDER, ROLL, DETERMINATION OF QUORUM

The meeting was called to order at 3:02 pm, the board members in attendance constituted a quorum.

## 2. PUBLIC COMMENT

Travis Petersen explained to the board that after 35 years of being held in Elko, the 2023 Nevada Safety Olympiad is being hosted in Winnemucca. It is a surface mine rescue competition sponsored by the Western Mine Rescue Association. Of the 11 teams signed up for the upcoming event, ten are from out of town. Each team typically has about 10 people in addition to the team mangers and vendors that are anticipated to stay in town for three or four nights. The event will be held August 16-18, 2023 at the Winnemucca Events Complex. The first day of the competition falls on the date of the August board meeting and Petersen wanted to give the board information about the event now. There will be a cooperative funding request on the August agenda.

## 7. GENERAL BUSINESS

7.1) Cumming Group/TSK, Joe Mackie (East) Hall exterior renovation project, presentation and review of project design proposals, and possible approval of design concepts for exterior building improvements and authorization to proceed with the project design and engineering phase, update on timeline

The team from Cumming and TSK presented two updated design options based on the input received from the board and staff at prior meetings. The board members expressed their preference for the option which has Winnemucca and East Hall lettering on the sides of the building facing Winnemucca Boulevard and Bridge Street. The Cumming Group/TSK team explained they will update the preliminary design documents and revise the cost estimates and present them at the August meeting.

7.2) Kent Arrien, Humboldt County Shooting Park, 2023 cooperative funding request, \$2,000 Kent Arrien, shooting park representative, requested funds to assist with the maintenance expenses at the shooting park. Arrien reported they are working on expanding the long-distance bay to 1,000 yards now that additional land from the BLM.

John Arant moved to approve awarding a \$2,000 grant as requested. Motion carried, 5-0.

7.3) Presentation, review and proposals for a capital improvement plan for the fiscal year ending on June 30, 2024 and the ensuing 5 fiscal years and authorization to submit the approved plan

Director Petersen reported: the Silver State International Rodeo was well attended and the new restroom/shower facility at the Winnemucca Events Complex was well received; a cutting show scheduled for mid-July at the WEC was cancelled due to not being able to procure cattle for the event; the Superior Livestock Auction is scheduled for the first of August; and, the Nevada State High School Rodeo Association received a protest to their approval of the multi-year agreement to host the event in Winnemucca, however, it is Petersen's understanding the protest has no merit since it was not properly made and it is anticipated to be finally settled at the NSHSRA meeting later in July.
